I hope the year has started well for you, and you are settling into 2024. I wonder what this year will bring? We often ask ourselves: will it be better or worse than the last? Whatever the answer, 2024 will be different, because change is part of life.

Change is already upon us; we have a new government. Other changes? New schools, jobs, projects? Family members leaving home? Falling in love?
